Yes, the individual or a family member is employed or has prospects to be soon employed (verify)

Individual is assessed about whether they are employed or have employment prospects

No, neither the individual nor any family member is employed or has job prospects.

The individual or family is offered options in local shelters. Preference for local shelters is **given only to those with local employment.**

But I have family here, lived here all my life. You can't force me to relocate.

The individual or family is offered the nearest available shelter options, which may be in another city or even another state.



I will not accept the shelter offered.

The only way we can prevent our cities being buried in homeless camps is by prohibiting street camping, and the only way we can do that is by creating shelter for all, and the only way we can shelter all w/o inordinate expense is to set up shelters where there is available less expensive land. That isn't in San Francisco, nor in Beverly Hills. We cannot "force you" to relocate but what we can do is make it impossible for you to live on the streets. Once you see that you cannot set up a tent on the sidewalk anywhere, it's your decision whether to accept shelter that is offered or continue to be chased around the city, have your tent torn down whenever you set it up. After 5 to 10 citations for illegal camping, you'll be fined and put in jail.

Those who "refuse services" will find themselves unable to set up a camp anywhere in the city. Police will seize tents and belongings, attended or not, and fine those who camp illegally in public places. Those using drugs in public will find that though Prop 47 makes it hard to convict and jail them, police will now **seize and destroy any illegal drugs found or being used anywhere in public.** Message will be, if you want to use drugs, you better do it in a private place or it will all be taken from you.

This is a hassle, I'll go to another city.

Other cities will have the same policy: if they don't, they will attract the drug addicts and criminals.
